Can be used neat on to refuse dumps, garbage and offal dumps.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

General deodourising: Disperse by low pressure spray (T12 trigger spray bottle), watering can or damp mop on to relevant area to neutralise foul odours. Always apply solution at the source of the odour. Leave to air dry.
